

Open Enrollment for health insurance coverage is here! From November 1 -December 15, individuals can log into

healthcare.gov and apply for new coverage, and renew or change their current plan.

To be eligible to enroll in Marketplace health coverage, you must live in the United States, be a US citizen or national (or be lawfully present), and not be incarcerated. All plans cover essential health benefits, pre-existing conditions, and preventative services.

Open enrollment ends on December 15, 2020, so don't wait!
